Steve,

In reference to the motion by Shelly Griffin and Justin Ambrose, please refer to the attached letter from SAGCD President Alan Robb, dated March 24, 2022. As President Robb states in this letter, no amendments to the MOU are being considered at this time.

Moreover, since President Robb sent this letter on March 24, the National Labor Relations Board has said that emergency list employees who worked 700 hours or more during contract year 2020-2021 should not have been placed on Extra List 5 **and should not have received any seniority preference**. The motion seeks to create two seniority categories in HH (HH1 and HH2), which would give a seniority preference to emergency list employees who worked 700 hours or more during 2020-21. Thus, this motion stands in clear conflict with the NLRB's stated position on this matter.

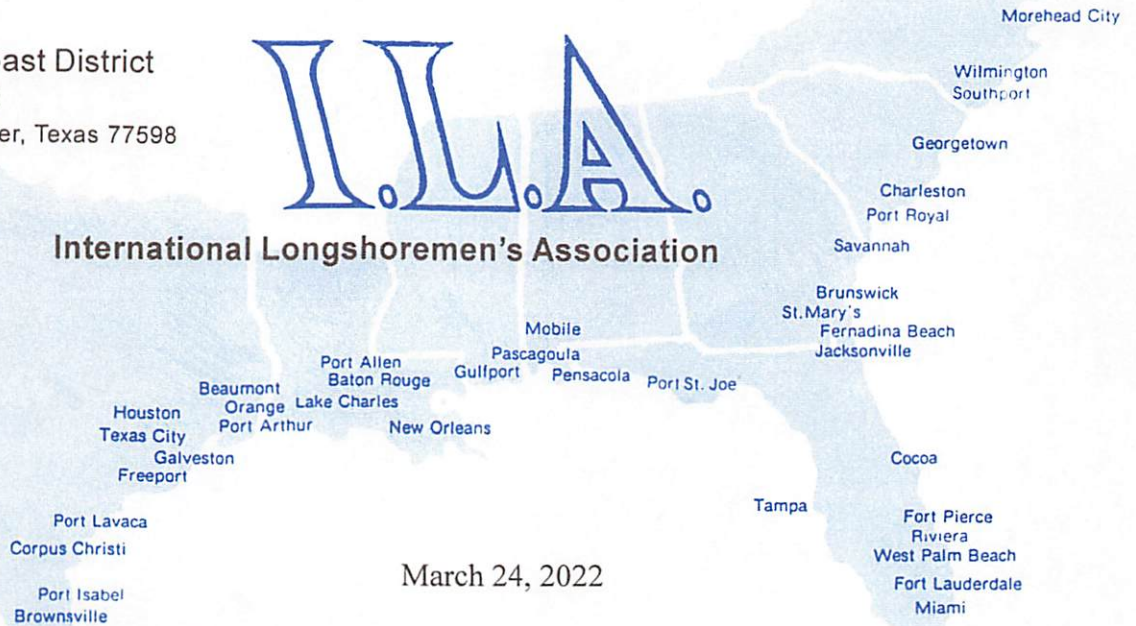
