

The following will begin in tonight's lineup (March 29, 2023) at 4pm and continue until further notice.

In an effort to comply with the Code of Ethics, outlined in Article 31 of the I.L.A. Constitution, the Executive Board has voted to implement an alphabetical rotation for the casual card (Z0) category until further notice. As outlined below:

- No Continuity.
- No Return Rights.
- You state your availability by Queuing Up for your job referral.
- Your Queue Up time stamp is null and void.
- No AOing with the exceptions of being Bypassed or vessel cancellations.
- Personnel who are queued up and available and are bypassed for not being qualified for the available jobs will be coded NQ (which stands for Not Qualified).
- If you are Bypassed, we will come back and pick you up in the same hiring period (day to day is the same hiring and night to night is the same hiring period) providing you were queued up and available for work. (i.e., dispatcher mistake, NQ, or cancellation). Will be verified by an Officer.
- Refer to ilasavannah.com for the rotation in the Day Pre Lineup and Night Pre Lineup Reports.
- Your current name will be used throughout this process.
- The rotation will begin with the person's last name and will start this evening with the letter A. It will be a continuous rotation.
