



1475 Safety Officer Roles and Responsibilities

1475 Safety Officer

- Monitor Netradyne System
 - Identify 1475 personnel that receive moderate or severe alerts.
 - Work with the Safety department to counsel and or report person for grievances.

- Audit all aspects of operations alongside the safety team to include the below list, report deficiencies and corrective-action recommendations with the safety department.
 - Gate and Rail Operations Audits - Audit personnel to ensure adherence to PPE, and safety rules governing gate and rail operations.
 - Field clerk audits - Audit personnel to ensure adherence to PPE, and safety rules governing yard operations.
 - Deck-Dock Audits – Audit personnel to ensure adherence to PPE, and safety rules governing vessel operations.
 - Clerk vehicle dispatch Audits - Audit labor during dispatch to ensure proper PPE, adherence to yard safety rules and pre-inspection of equipment being dispatched.

- Attend/conduct pre vessel Safety Talks as practical within scope of other duties.
- Attend and participate in local grievances.
- The Safety Officer will not work on the docks in any capacity. No checker/clerk work but can be on the dock to work their Safety Officer role.
- The Safety Officer will be responsible for monitoring 1475 employees only.
- Must be physically capable of climbing gangway, climbing vessel ladders to vessel catwalks, walking the dock and interchange lanes.
- The Safety Officer will be a 1-year obligation that will run from October 1st to September 30th. This job will be offered by seniority on a yearly basis.
- The Safety Officer will work Exclusively for Gateway and cannot be officer of the local. *Jan 503*
- Other duties as assigned.
- Either party can opt out of this agreement with 30 days written notice.
