

floating keyboard android

Most Android devices can enable a floating keyboard using the built-in Gboard or Samsung Keyboard apps. This feature allows you to detach the keyboard from the bottom of the screen, move it freely, and resize it for more comfortable typing.

Enable the floating keyboard with Gboard

1. Open an app that lets you type to display the keyboard.
2. Tap the four squares icon (or the arrow) in the toolbar above the keyboard to expand the menu of options. If you don't see it, tap the three-dots menu icon.
3. Select the Floating option from the expanded menu. The keyboard will detach from the bottom of the screen and be surrounded by a gray border.
4. To move the keyboard, tap and drag the handle at the bottom.
5. To resize it, tap and drag one of the corners.

Enable the floating keyboard on a Samsung device

1. Go to your phone's Settings app.
2. Navigate to General management, then tap on Samsung Keyboard settings.
3. Tap Mode.
4. Choose Floating keyboard for either Portrait view, Landscape view, or both
